CIRCULAR

Sub: Permission to leave campus on suspected COVID-19 cases,
to help in prevention / reduction of the transmission of the virus.

In the light of the Advisory issued by the GoI and the Government of Telangana on the spread of COVID-19 to certain parts of India as well some parts of Telangana particularly in Hyderabad, the stakeholders of the UoH Campus viz., the students, teachers and NT staff both regular and outsourcing employees are advised to take necessary precautions issued from time to time by the UoH and other relevant sources, to not to get affected by the Corona Virus. If any stakeholder with travel history to any COVID-19 affected country or in contact with such persons in the last 28 days, should inform Incharge Chief Medical Officer (CMO) so that they can be monitored and taken care of. Alternatively, they are advised, if they wish, to be home quarantined for 14 days. Such individuals may please approach the Health Centre voluntarily with their ID Cards to get a certificate from the Incharge Chief Medical Officer to proceed to their homes.

Upon completing of the quarantined period they can return back to the campus only after certification by the treating doctor at their hometown. They can then approach the Incharge CMO of the Health Centre for the issue of the **Certificate of Fitness** to join back to their duties or studies. The Incharge CMO will be communicating the details of affected cases along with ID details to the Registrar / Controller of Examinations as the case may be.
