**Sub: Submission of Hard Copy of Application - Social Welfare Scholarship, Govt of  
Telangana for the year 2020-21 – Physical Verification – Reg.**

The students of Integrated Masters' and Masters' Programme who have applied for Social Welfare Scholarship of Govt. of Telangana for the year 2020-21 through e-Pass are requested to submit their hard copy of the application along with the following documents duly attested by the Gazetted Officer for physical verification at the University level:-

- Copies of educational qualifications from SSC to Last Qualifying Certificate
- Copies of bonafide / conduct certificates of last 07 years
- Copies of Caste Certificate, Adhaar Card, Bank Passbook
- **Income Certificate (Original) – Fresher**
- **Affidavit declaring the annual Income of the family (Original) – Renewal**
- Copies of the Conditional Admit Card and Semester Registration
- Copy of the Transfer Certificate (for Fresher)
- Copy of the GAP Certificate, if applicable

Mere submission of application on e-Pass does not entitle the student for consideration to sanction Scholarship by the Govt. of Telangana, unless the physical verification at the University level & Adhaar authentication by the student is done and the hard copy of application along with the required documents is forwarded to the Social Welfare Department for necessary further action.


In view of the above and due to pandemic situation, all the students are hereby advised to send the Hard Copy of application along with the above documents, by SPEED POST only to the following address for verification at the University latest by 19-04-2021:-

After Institute Verification of the application, the student shall authenticate it with their Adhaar through "Mee Seva Centre" and inform the Fellowships & Scholarships Section. Later, on communication from the FSS, the student shall necessarily come to the University, following COVID-19 guidelines issued by the Government of India, to sign on their Bar Coded Application which will be forwarded to the Social Welfare Department along with all the supporting documents.
