CIRCULAR

Unfortunately, a number of positive cases are reported in the University of Hyderabad campus among the students, teachers and non-teaching inspite of strict masures/guidelines of COVID-19 that have been adhered to and followed by the stakeholders of the University. However, we could not curb the increase in positive cases in the campus, as the present virus could be Double/Triple Mutant which is a fresh worry in COVID battle.

In the light of the above, the Health Centre has been taking all required steps that are essential to combat the present pandemic in the campus. The following are some of the steps that have been taken by the Health Centre to assist the campus community during this pandemic :

1. The Health Centre has been providing online facility for medical advice on the dedicated Mobile Telephone No.9440227517 (in a Telemedicine mode) on the health concerns of the Campus Community. This is apart from the emergency duties of the Medical Officers on 24x7 basis along with nursing and paramedical staff.
2. Written letters to the District Medical and Health Officer, Sivarampalli, Rajendra Nagar for arranging inhouse campus facility for testing and also vaccination, with a hope to receive a positive reply in this regard.
3. Arranged a dedicated vehicle for transporting suspected / COVID-19 positive persons and to provide necessary medical assistance. The same vehicle is also available at Lakeview Guest house on 24x7 basis.
4. The Health Centre Provides necessary medical kits for the COVID-19 positive persons and also provides PPE Kits, face shields, face masks and sanitizers to all drivers allotted to the dedicated vehicles and also to all Health Centre Staff.
5. Arrangements are made for providing First-Aid Medical Kits to deal with COVID cases to the concerned.
6. Special arrangements are made for campus community for vaccination (COVAXIN) in Citizen Hospital, Gopanapalli without seeking any prior appointment between 2 to 4 PM. The campus community and their families may avail this facility. The contact at Citizen Hospital is **Mr Arun-86860 00068**, Coordinator for Vaccination at Citizen Hospital. However, this facility is operative once the vaccin is available in the hospital, as there is a shortage of vaccination at present.

In the light of the above, it is once again requested to all the stakeholders to follow COVID-19 guidelines strictly by wearing facemasks, sanitizaing hands, maintaining physical distances and by avoiding physical contact and unnecessary movements in the campus to combat the virus together, at the earlist possible in order to restore normalcy in the campus.
