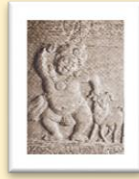

#### ABOUT THE COURSE

This inter-disciplinary course looks at time and space over the *longue duree* to highlight human interventions and engagements with 'wild' landscapes that transformed human-non-human co-habitation followed by a domesticating of the 'wild' and finally, leading to its conquest. Examining this process and its representations becomes an intersectional theme that runs through this course.

It is proposed to communicate these ideas through archaeological data, the text and written word, the visual in historical perspective and the oral as memorized encompassing but, cutting across disciplines of archaeology, linguistics, literature, archival studies, history, art history, anthropology and folklore.
