4. If a quotation **is not from** the original manufacturer, then name of the manufacturer must be mentioned for each item. When a quotation is from the Indian Agent a letter of authorization from the Principals must be included.
5. University of Hyderabad will not hold any responsibility for postal/courier delay.
6. The quotations should be complete in all respects, with all the specific details requested; additional brochures may be included.
7. If the quotation is not from the original manufacturer, the name and address of the manufacturer must be mentioned for each item. When a quotation is from the Indian representative a letter of authorization from the Principals, to quote and negotiate on their behalf, is to be included.
8. **The purchase policy of the University of Hyderabad is applicable (Please check the University website for further details).**
9. The quotations must be super scribed with the **Reference number** given above and **due date** along with **the item name**.
10. **No Agency Commission:** If the quotation is not from the original manufacturer, the name and address of the manufacturer must be mentioned for each item. When a quotation is from the Indian representative, a letter of authorization from the Principals, to quote and negotiate on their behalf, is to be included. The University does not give agency commission.
11. The purchase transaction will be governed by a purchase agreement to be entered into, by the University of Hyderabad and the equipment supplier.
12. **Liquidated Damages:** The foreign manufacturer/supplier or his Indian representative shall pay to the University @ 1% of the total cost of the system/equipment/material per week of delay in delivery of the system which in no case shall exceed 5% of the total cost. Liquidated Damages will not be applicable where the cause of delay is not attributable to the foreign manufacturer/supplier/representative.
13. **Risk purchase clause:** If the supplier fails to deliver the ordered material(s) within the maximum delivery period specified in the purchase order, we may procure such item(s) and in such a manner as deemed appropriate, goods or services similar to those undelivered, and the supplier will be liable to the University for any excess costs for such similar goods or services.
14. The right to consider/reject any quotation rests entirely with the University of Hyderabad.
