UPDATE ON CAMPUS COVID -19 VACCINATION DRIVE

Thanks to each one of you who have responded enthusiastically and positively seeking Covaxin by providing the necessary information for conveying the number of doses that may be required for university stakeholders.

The administration is now fully seized of the matter and has now a reasonable estimate to proceed further with arranging the procurement and vaccination in the campus with Covaxin.

There are also requests for Covishield as vaccination of choice among the stakeholders; both as first dose and as well as those who want the second dose; among the university community. We have also looked at Sputnik V as another option being in Hyderabad and having our good relationships with DRL which is spearheading this vaccine roll-out.


In this connection, the administration wishes to convey the following updates:

- We have progressed with making headway with securing the vaccination doses and planning the vaccination drive through trusted hospitals. This applies to stakeholders & dependents who have provided information through the form. They also include our frontline staff from the outsourcing agencies and our resident scholars and students currently in the campus.
- We want to assure that we are energetically pursuing many efforts through various formal and informal routes and have a contingency plan also in place to make this vaccination drive happen at the earliest time.
- The timeline that may be of immense help to all the campus stakeholders are:
 - a. Decision on closing the viable option and ordering the drive end week by 7th June 2021;
 - b. Scheduling the vaccination drive during 10-20 June 2021.

While thanking you again immensely for your co-operation, we wish to implore and re-inforce the fact that anybody having scheduled slots for vaccination already on their own or through any other special drive should go ahead and get their vaccinations done as per the dates secured.
