Revised Guidelines

1. GENERAL

University of Hyderabad has decided to extent "financial assistance" under the scheme titled "University of Hyderabad Students Assistance (UoH-SA)" @ Rs. 1,000/- per month (enhanced from the existing amount of Rs. 750/-) to a maximum of 1200 students. 600 students of Masters and Integrated Masters Programme admitted during the year 2018-19 will be eligible to receive the enhanced financial assistance from July, 2019 to April, 2020. In respect of fresh students admitted during the year 2019-2020, a maximum of 600 students will get the assistance from the date of joining or August, 2019 whichever is later to till April, 2020.

2. ELIGIBILITY

- All the ongoing and newly joined students of Integrated and Masters Programme.
- The students whose parental income is less than Rs. 8.00 lakhs are eligible for sanction of UoH-SA

3. APPLICATION PROCEDURE

The application may be downloaded from the website of University.

4. SELECTION PROCEDURE

Sanction of fellowship will be based on the following four components and their respective points on a 100 point scale as given below:

<i>Economic Background</i>	:	<i>50 points</i>
<i>Merit in the qualifying examination</i>	:	<i>30 points</i>
<i>Social Background</i>	:	<i>10 points</i>
<i>Backward Region</i>	:	<i>10 points</i>
<i>(as per the Govt. of India Notification on classification of backward districts)</i>

5. SCRUTINY AND PROCESS

- The applications are to be processed by the concerned School. For this purpose a Committee may be constituted at School level. The Committee shall ensure that the process is fair and transparent. Senior officials from Academic and Finance wing may be co-opted.
- After scrutiny, the School shall forward the list of shortlisted students in the following format to the Asst. Registrar, Fellowships and Scholarships Section.

If more applications than the number of slots available for UoH-SA are received, a formula will be evaluated such that the students who scored lesser points be removed by a process where no student belonging to any community shall have apprehension of not considering his/her application for no valid reason.

6. DOCUMENTS REQUIRED

- Copy of Caste Certificate (in case of SC/ST/OBC).
- Copy of Income Certificate (issued by Mandal Revenue Officer / Tahsildar for annual income up to Rs. 2.00 lakhs. In case of annual income in excess of Rs. 2.00 lakhs, a declaration of the parent duly supported by the pay slip etc. to be enclosed.
- Copy of Bank Pass Book.
- Copy of Admit Card.
- Copy of Semester Registration Card.
- If the annual income of the parents is between Rs. 2.00 lakhs and Rs. 8.00 lakhs and no certificate from Revenue Department is produced, the information provided in the admission form by the student will be relied upon.

7. STIPEND


The assistance will be @ Rs. 1,000/- per month.

8. TENURE

The tenure will be for 10 months in an academic year. UoH-SA will be paid from July 2019 to April 2020 for ongoing students and from date of Joining or August, 2019 whichever is later to till April 2020, for freshers.

OTHER TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- Any proven charge of misbehaviour or misconduct with the fellow students / teachers / non-teaching staff / service providers on the campus will be considered as disqualification for applying for and discontinuation of UoH-SA.
- Readmitted students are not eligible for applying / claiming the UoH-SA.
- Students who discontinue the course or admitted for another integrated / postgraduate courses are not eligible for UoH-SA.
- Students pursuign the Masters Programme for second time are also not eligible for UoH-SA.
- The recipient of the UoH-SA should have satisfactory academic progress during their course period.
- 75% monthly attendance is mandatory for releasing the UoH-SA.
- If a student gets financial assistance from any other source, i.e., from PG Merit Scholarship, Single Girl Scholarship, University Rank Holders, Professional Courses for SC/ST students and National Board for Higher Mathematics (NBHM), etc. he/she will not be eligible for UoH-SA.
- In case a student discontinues / leaves during the current semester of the Programme/Course, the entire sanctioned amount of UoH-SA is to be refunded to the University.

Addendum to the CIRCULAR

Sub: Revised Selection Procedure for sanction of UoH SA for ongoing students –Reg.
Ref: 1. Circular No: UH/FO/F&S/2019/1864 Dt. 14.08.2019
2. Vice-Chancellor's approval dated 11.10.2019

In continuation to the circular cited first, the following clarifications may please be noted:

- I. The enhanced financial assistance under the scheme of UoH SA of Rs. 1000/-p.m. is applicable for all ongoing students for Masters and Integrated Masters Programme, subject to meeting the terms and conditions laid down in the Revised Guidelines Dt. 14.08.2019 from the Academic year 2019-2020.
- II. If the annual Income of the parents is less than Rs. 2.00 lakh and no certificate from Revenue Department (MRO/Tahsildar) is produced, the information provided in the admission form by the student may be relied upon. **This relaxation is for one time measure and not to be quoted as precedence in future Academic years.**
- III. The Merit points (i.e. 30) awarded for qualifying exam may be ignored for freshers. However for ongoing students merit points may be awarded based on their performance during last year (previous semester).
