APPEAL TO THE STUDENTS

It is informed that consumption / possession of Drugs, illicit liquor and other prohibitory material are totally banned in our Campus as per Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act 1985 (Shortened to NDPS Act) enacted by the Government of India.

Any student(s) found with either possession / consuming of Drugs is / are punishable under the above Act and they will be attracted with rigorous imprisonment for a term which shall not be less than 10 years but which may extended to 20 years and shall also be liable to fine which shall not be less than Rs. 1.00 lakh but which may extended to Rs. 2.00 lakh also. The consumption of prohibitory material in our campus are also punishable which may even lead to severe punishment.

In view of the above, I appeal all the students, to make a note of the above and advised not to involve yourselves in such cases. If any student (s) are found involved in such cases, apart from imprisonment, please note that they will be punished under Rule II (1) of the Rules of Discipline and Proper Conduct for the Students of University of Hyderabad.

I appeal to all our students to be very cautious and not to indulge in such cases which may affect the career as well as peaceful atmosphere in the Campus. It is appealed to all our students to inform the undersigned, either through e-mail (dsw-office@uohyd.ac.in) or to the Security office (040-23131000) about if anyone either using or in possession of such drugs, to enable us to provide psychological counselling services to such student. Such information received will also be kept confidential.
