CIRCULAR

Sub: University Grants Commission (Minimum Qualifications for Appointment of Teachers and Other Academic Staff in Universities and Colleges and Measures for the Maintenance of Standards in Higher Education) (3rd Amendment) Regulations, 2023 – Career Advancement Scheme – Reg.

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Attention of the faculty is drawn to the Gazette Notification issued by the UGC on 31st July, 2023, amending certain provisions of the principal regulations published vide No. F.1-2/2017 (EC/PS) dated 18th July, 2018.

The salient features of the amendments to the UGC Regulations, 2018 with regard to the provisions of **Career Advancement Scheme** enumerated below are brought to the notice of the faculty:

Clause 3.12

No person shall be appointed in any University or in any of institutions including constituent or affiliated colleges recognised under clause (f) of Section 2 or in any deemed to be a University under Section 3 of UGC Act, 1956, if such person does not fulfil the requirements as to the qualifications for the appropriate post as provided in UGC Regulations.

Clause 6.3 - Extension of date to apply for promotion under CAS as per UGC Regulations 2010.

- i. The criteria for promotions under CAS laid down under these Regulations shall be effective from the date of notification of these Regulations.
- ii. However, to avoid hardship to those faculty members who have already qualified or are likely to qualify within six months (till 17th January, 2019) as per the UGC Regulations 2010, a choice may be given to them, either for being considered for promotion under the 2010 or 2018 Regulations.
- iii. This option can be exercised only up to 31st December 2023 and the date of eligibility shall be retained as the date of promotion. On the date of submission of the application, the candidate should fulfil all the eligibility criteria required for promotion.

Clause 6.3. VI (iii) - Date of eligibility for promotion in respect of rejected candidates

- i. The candidate who does not succeed in the first assessment, shall have to be re-assessed only after one year.
- ii. When such a candidate succeeds in the eventual assessment, his/ her promotion shall be effected either from 1st January or 1st July depending on the date of eventual assessment.
 - a) *If the eventual assessment is between 1st January and 30th June of a year, the promotion shall be granted from 1st July of the year.*
 - b) *If the eventual assessment is between 1st July and 31st December of a year, the promotion shall be granted from 1st January of next year.*

Clause 6.3. VIII

Wherever, the requirement of the Orientation Course/ Refresher course has remained incomplete, the promotion would not be held up, but these requirements should be fulfilled by 31st December 2023 or as notified by the Commission from time to time.

S. No. 3 under Table 3A of UGC Regulations, 2018

The provision for award of scores is extended to other streams also- *M.Phil/ LLM/ M.Tech/ M.Arch/ M.E/ M.V.Sc. / M.D etc.*

S. No. D under the category of Note below Table 3A of UGC Regulations, 2018


SLET/SET score shall be valid for appointment in respective State Universities/ Colleges/ Institutions only.

The above amendments came into effect from **31-07-2023**, i.e., the date of publication of the amendments in the Gazette of India.

• **Submission of applications under the provisions of UGC Regulations 2010/16: -**

As per the above clause 6.3 of the UGC Regulations, the faculty members who fulfil the eligibility criteria for promotion within six months from the notification of UGC Regulations, 2018, i.e., by **17-01-2019** and wish to be considered for CAS promotion to the next grade/next Academic Level under UGC Regulations 2010 may submit their applications with relevant enclosures to the Recruitment Cell.

Further, the teachers who have already applied in response to the University Circular 20th June, 2022 (one time opportunity) and currently on rolls/service of the University may update their applications in case they wish to do so.
