ADVISORY TO THE STUDENTS

Sub: Prohibition of alcohol/ narcotics consumption on the campus – reg

Consumption or possession of drugs, illicit liquor, and other prohibited substances is strictly banned on our campus as per the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act 1985 (NDPS Act) enacted by the Government of India.

Any student caught engaging in activities involving the possession, sale, purchase, transportation, or consumption of drugs will face severe punishment under the NDPS Act. The consequences are stringent, including a minimum of ten years of rigorous imprisonment and a fine of at least Rs. 1.00 lakh.

Based on the information provided, I insist that all students take note of the above and refrain from engaging in direct or indirect encouragement of or the consumption of drugs. Your cooperation is essential in maintaining a drug-free campus and fostering a peaceful atmosphere for all.

All students must play a crucial role in ensuring a drug-free campus.
