A recent incident at Mens' Hostel-I highlights this concern, where a student fell from the third floor and sustained severe injuries to his kidneys, spleen, and bones, along with significant brain injuries, ultimately resulting in his untimely death.

We are deeply saddened by the loss of this young student, who had a promising future ahead of him. Such a tragedy impacts not only his family but also our entire campus community. I urge you to always consider your loved parents and siblings when engaging in any activities related to substance abuse.


I would like to remind everyone that the consumption or possession of drugs, illicit alcohol, and other prohibited substances is strictly prohibited on our campus. This is in accordance with the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act of 1985 (NDPS Act), enacted by the Government of India.

I urge all students to take this matter seriously and avoid any direct or indirect involvement with drug use or the encouragement of such behavior. Your cooperation is essential in maintaining a drug-free campus and fostering a safe and peaceful environment for everyone.
